- e. “Applicant/Licensee” means the Institution, Corporation or Company submitting the application in the case of Juristic Person applications, and the responsible individual in the case of Natural Person applications.
- f. “Use” means to possess, store, manufacture, sell, operate, import, export or any other meaning given in the legislation.
- g. “radioactive source” means radioactive material that is unsealed or permanently sealed in a capsule or closely bonded, in a solid form and which is not exempt from regulatory control and includes any radioactive material released through the breakage or leaking of such a source. It does not include nuclear material or material encapsulated for disposal.
