CONDITIONS

1. A Registered importer shall be required to apply for an Import Permit
2. A Registered importer shall be required to have a valid Forestry Produce import Licence;
3. A Registered importer shall provide the following details: invoices showing particulars of importer, particulars of importer, bank details of importer, country of origin, quantity and import value of forestry products to be imported;
4. An Import Permit shall be on a consignment basis and shall be valid for a period of 21 days from the date of issue;
5. The Department of Forestry may undertake physical inspection of the consignment prior to issuance of a permit to verify, among other things, quantity and value of forestry products imported.
6. Imports of forestry produce shall be done in accordance with Reserve Bank of Malawi import regulations and guidelines.
7. An Import Permit shall only be issued upon meeting the required phytosanitary standards;
8. Import permits shall only be issued on Mondays after seven days from the application date.
